- Volunteers should be active TACA Mentors. Qualified applicants would be Mentors who have completed all TACA training, completed data, and are able and willing to accept matches or are actively mentoring. New mentors should be active for a minimum of three months before applying. In addition, TACA Mentors should be:
 - Responsive to the TACA Mentor Coordinator;
 - TACA Leadership may be engaged in Peer Mentoring (providing mentoring, coaching and development to Mentors in their community);
 - As of the start date of the benefit, TACA mentors who may have been retired for longer than 6 months need to demonstrate three (3) months of activity to become eligible to apply.
- Volunteer in Good Standing: has provided data for all of 2024, commits to completing data monthly for the duration of the program incentive, and has completed all training.
